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*MAILING OF AMNESTY REMINDER LETTERS*

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**PURPOSE OF BULLETIN** To advise staff that we will begin mailing amnesty reminder letters on May 16, 2005, to taxpayers who filed for amnesty and have an outstanding amnesty year balance and/or missing returns. Many taxpayers who receive these letters may contact our public service staff.

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**BACKGROUND** The Amnesty program application period ran from February 1, 2005, through March 31, 2005. Taxpayers have until May 31, 2005, to file missing or amended returns, make payment in full, or establish an amnesty installment agreement.

Taxpayers who filed for amnesty and have an outstanding balance and/or missing returns will receive a reminder letter. The reminder letter is general in nature and not account specific; the only variable information on the letter is the name and address.

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**MAILING SCHEDULE AND VOLUMES** We anticipate mailing approximately 125,000 amnesty reminder letters to taxpayers (about 13,000 business entities) beginning May 16, 2005.

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**TAXPAYER INQUIRIES** Follow appropriate amnesty procedures, informing taxpayers and their representatives of the requirements to participate in amnesty.
