SUBJECT: Increase Household Income Figures For HRA By 45%

Assembly Bill 426 (Cardoza), as enacted on August 7, 2001, made the following changes to California law:

Section 20543 of the Revenue and Taxation Code is amended.

This act provides an increase of 45% in the household income amounts that are used to determine eligibility and the amount of the homeowners assistance payments for low-income seniors and disabled individuals. The maximum total household income amount is increased to \$51,114, and the maximum gross household income amount is increased to \$92,935.

Section 20544 of the Revenue and Taxation Code is amended.

This act provides an increase of 45% in the household income amounts that are used to determine eligibility and the amount of the renters assistance payments for low-income seniors and disabled individuals. The maximum total household income amount is increased to \$51,114, and the maximum gross household income amount is increased to \$92,935.

As an urgency measure, this act is effective upon enactment and applies to claims filed for the calendar year beginning January 1, 2001.

This act will not require any reports by the department to the Legislature.
