SUMMARY

This bill would make various revisions to the existing Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act, including, but not limited to:

- defining the term "meeting";
- requiring a posted agenda for all teleconference meetings; and
- requiring a notice posted on the Internet when a state body intends to take action on items not included on a posted agenda.

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT

The June 28, 2001, amendments would delete a provision of the Government Code and replace it with language that reflects recently enacted law. The June 28 amendments also would make minor technical changes and correct cross-references within the provision.

The department's analysis of the bill as introduced on February 7, 2001, still applies.
