SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT

The August 5, 2002, amendments made minor technical changes and incorporated one of the department's proposed amendments. As a result, the technical consideration regarding unnecessary language has been partially resolved. The remainder of the department's analysis of the bill as amended June 17, 2002, still applies.
