SUMMARY

This bill would change the appropriation procedure for the California Peace Officer Memorial Foundation Fund.

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT

The June 26, 2001, amendment would require the California Peace Officer Memorial Commission to report to the Legislature on or before December 31, 2003, regarding the status of the peace officer memorial construction.

Except for this new reporting requirement and the department's position change, the remainder of the department's analysis of this bill as introduced February 13, 2001, still applies.
