## SUMMARY

This bill would:

- Preclude certain documents relating to an agency's security from being disclosed to the public; and
- Allow state bodies to temporarily, until January 1, 2006, hold closed session meetings to discuss matters relating to certain criminal or terrorist activity.

## SUMMARY OF AMENDMENTS

With these July 15, 2003, amendments:

- Security information that would not be subject to public disclosure would be limited to those documents that assess vulnerability to terrorist attacks or other criminal acts as specified, and would expressly include customer lists provided to local agencies by alarm or security companies.
- Closed session meetings would be limited to criminal or terrorist activities against property specifically identified and would only be eligible for closed session meetings temporarily, until January 1, 2006, instead of permanently.
