COMMENTS:

This bill would prohibit the public posting or displaying of any portion of an individual's social security number (SSN) consisting of four or more consecutive digits.

The March 8th amendment extended the prohibition to the displaying of four or more consecutive digits. Since the department does not currently publicly post or display any portion of an SSN, this change does not affect the department. The previous analysis of the bill as introduced January 13, 2004, still applies.
