## COMMENTS:

This bill would prohibit the public posting or displaying of any portion of an individual's social security number (SSN) with the knowledge that it is a portion of an SSN.

The April 12, 2004, amendment removed language prohibiting the display of four or more consecutive digits and replaced it with language prohibiting the displaying of any portion of an SSN with the knowledge that it is a portion of an SSN. Since the department does not currently publicly post or display any portion of an SSN, this change does not affect the department. The previous analysis of the bill as introduced January 13, 2004, still applies.
