COMMENTS:

This bill would allow a state agency to provide its employees, at each employee's election, with an electronic itemized salary or wage statement in lieu of a statement in writing.

The June 2, 2003, amendment makes the electronic statement provision contingent upon the State Controller's "21st Century Project" being funded and implemented. Additionally, the amendment specifies that the wage statement would be provided only to the extent the project enables the Controller to provide the information electronically. These changes would not impact the department. The department's previous analysis dated February 14, 2003, still applies.
