This bill would limit the number of reports made by a state or local agency to the Legislature, Governor, or any state legislative or executive body.

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENTS

The June 26th amendments:

- Allow a public agency the option of preparing or submitting any written report not specified under this bill to the Legislature, Governor, or any state legislative or executive body.
- Add several more reports that would continue to be prepared and submitted to the Legislature, Governor, or any state legislative or executive body.
- Require a public agency to continue responding to requests for information by a state employee's or state university employee's representative.

The June 26th amendments resolve the department's implementation considerations discussed in the department's analysis of the bill as amended May 27, 2003. The remainder of the department's analysis as introduced December 23, 2002, still applies.
