## SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT

The May 1, 2003, amendment would move the fund allocation language into the Revenue and Taxation Code.

The amendment also added coauthors and made other non-substantive, technical changes that would not impact the department. The remainder of the department's analysis of the bill as amended April 3, 2003, still applies.

## TECHNICAL CONSIDERATION

With the May 1, 2003, amendment, Section 1051 of the Military and Veterans Code would not contain allocation instructions. To avoid confusion, the author may wish to consider deleting the reference "pursuant to Section 1051 of the Military and Veterans Code." Amendment 1 is attached.

**AMENDMENT 1**
