SUBJECT: Public Records/Public Agency Security

Assembly Bill 1209 (Nakano), made the following changes to California law:

This act precludes public disclosure of any of the following:

- Vulnerability assessments developed by or for a state or local agency that identifies potential targets of terrorist or other criminal acts.
- Customer lists provided to state or local police agencies by an alarm or security company.

This act is effective and operative immediately.

This act does not require any reports by the department to the Legislature.
