SUBJECT: Court Ordered Debt/Allows Superior Courts To Refer Delinquent Amounts To FTB For Collection/FTB & Judicial Council Seek Additional Resources Needed To Accept Referrals From All 58 Counties

Senate Bill 246 (Escutia), made the following changes to California law:Section 19280 of the Revenue and Taxation Code is amended.

This act explicitly allows California superior courts to refer delinquent fines, penalties, and restitution orders directly to the Franchise Tax Board (FTB) for collection.

This act requires FTB, in conjunction with the Judicial Council, to seek whatever additional resources are needed to accept collection referrals from all 58 counties or superior courts.

Section 19283 of the Revenue and Taxation Code is amended.

This act repeals the sunset date of the existing court ordered debt collection program.

This act is effective and operative beginning January 1, 2005.

This act will not require any reports by the department to the Legislature.
