SUBJECT: National World War II Veterans Memorial Trust Fund

**Assembly Bill 214 (Horton), as enacted on September 9, 2004, made the following changes to California law:**

Section 1350 of the Military and Veterans Code is amended.

This act specifies that the moneys in the trust fund be appropriated to the State Controller for allocation to the American Battle Monuments Commission.

Section 18702 of the Revenue and Taxation Code is amended.

This act specifies that the Controller may receive direct actual costs for the administration of the funds. This act also specifies that all funds deposited in the National World War II Veterans Memorial Trust Fund must be allocated in accordance to the Military and Veterans Code described above.

This act is effective January 1, 2005.

This act will not require any reports by the department to the Legislature.
