This bill would amend the Civil Code and the Welfare and Institutions Code to provide limitations on the personal information a state agency may disclose for statistical research and reporting.

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENTS**

The June 9<sup>th</sup> amendments provide additional guidelines for a researcher's plan to protect personal information and additional guidelines for the review and approval of research projects conducted by the Committee for the Protection of Human Subjects. The remainder of the department's analysis of the bill as introduced on December 6, 2004, still applies.
