This bill would prevent state agencies or their agents from charging a fee for using a credit card unless the same fee is charged for use of a check or cash.

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENTS

The April 12, 2005, amendments specify that in addition to state agencies and their agents, the provisions of this bill are also applicable to the University of California and the California State University and their agents.

The remainder of the previous analysis of the bill as introduced on February 22, 2005, is still applicable.
