SUBJECT: State Agency Computers/Unlawful to Knowingly Use State-Owned or State-Leased Computers to Access, View, Download or Otherwise Obtain Obscene Matter

**Assembly Bill 546 (Garcia, et al.), as enacted on September 30, 2006, made the following changes to California law:**

Section 8314.5 of the Government Code is added.

This act makes it unlawful for any elected state or local officer, including any state or local appointee, employee, or consultant, to knowingly use a state-owned or state-leased computer to access, view, download, or otherwise obtain obscene matter.

This act is effective on January 1, 2008, and is operative as of that date.

This act will not require any reports by the department to the Legislature.
