COMMENTS:

This bill would require a state agency to include specific information on its web site about requesting copies of public records.

The July 17, 2007, amendments changed the operative date by which state agencies must have the required information available on their web sites from January 1, 2009, to July 1, 2009, and changed the date by which the Department of Justice task force would provide a report to the Legislature from September 30, 2008, to January 1, 2009. The July 17, 2007, amendments also made nonsubstantive technical changes that do not impact the department’s programs or operations or impact state tax revenue. The remainder of the department’s analysis of the bill as amended June 28, 2007, still applies.
