COMMENTS:

This bill would limit usage by state agencies of devices utilizing radio waves to read identification documents remotely.

The April 17, 2007, amendments removed sanctions for a person that discloses or causes to disclose certain operational system keys. The April 19, 2007, amendments expanded the scope of the existing law related to the intentional disclosure of medical, psychiatric, or psychological information. The amendments do not impact the department's programs, operations, or costs. The remainder of the department's analysis of the bill as introduced December 4, 2006, still applies.
