This bill would make it a crime to read or attempt to read personal identification documents using radio waves without the owner’s knowledge or consent.

The March 20, 2007, amendments removed an exception that excluded documents created for the limited use of collecting funds for the use of a toll bridge from the requirements of this bill. These changes do not impact the department and the analysis of the bill as introduced December 6, 2006, remains applicable.
