SUBJECT: FTB Authority For California Child Support Automated System Transferred To Department Of Child Support System

Assembly Bill 1279 (Assembly Budget Committee), as enacted on September 30, 2008, made the following changes to laws impacting the Franchise Tax Board:

Section 10080.5 of the Welfare and Institutions Code is added.

This act transfers Franchise Tax Board's (FTB) duties and authority for California Child Support Automated System (CCSAS) to the Department of Child Support Services (DCSS). DCSS will be substituted for FTB in any agreements that FTB has entered into to implement CCSAS.

This act authorizes DCSS to enter into an interagency agreement with FTB to continue any services necessary to be provided by FTB for ongoing support of CCSAS. The agreement may provide for the transfer of staff from FTB to DCSS upon federal notification that the single statewide CCSAS is implemented in all jurisdictions, or on January 1, 2009, whichever is later.

Section 10082 of the Welfare and Institutions Code is amended.

This act removes certain references to FTB within the statute.

Section 10083 of the Welfare and Institutions Code is repealed.

As an urgency statute, this act is effective immediately upon enactment and operative as of that date.

This act will not require any reports by the department to the Legislature.
