SUBJECT: Emergency Food Assistance Program Fund/Extend Repeal Date To January 1, 2014

Senate Bill 1101 (Cedillo), as enacted on July 25, 2008, made the following changes to laws impacting the Franchise Tax Board:

Section 18851 of the Revenue and Taxation Code is amended.

This act changed the name of the voluntary contribution fund to be shown on the Personal Income Tax (PIT) return from Emergency Food Assistance Program Fund to the Emergency Food for Families Fund.

Section 18852 of the Revenue and Taxation Code is amended.

This act made nonsubstantive conforming changes to this statute.

Section 18853 of the Revenue and Taxation Code is amended.

This act made nonsubstantive conforming changes to this statute.

Section 18855 of the Revenue and Taxation Code is amended.

This act extended the repeal date for the Emergency Food for Families Fund to appear on the PIT return to January 1, 2014. This fund will last appear on the 2013 PIT return filed in 2014, unless it fails to meet the minimum contribution amount or a later enacted statute deletes or extends that date.

This act is effective on January 1, 2009, and operative as of that date.

This act will not require any reports by the department to the Legislature.
