SUBJECT

Code Maintenance

PURPOSE OF BILL

This bill would make numerous technical, non-substantive changes as a matter of code maintenance to various California codes, including to the Revenue and Taxation Code. These changes would include punctuation, grammar, and reference corrections. As such, this bill would not impact the department's programs and operations or the state's income tax revenue.

EFFECTIVE/OPERATIVE DATE

Assuming enactment in 2009, this bill would become effective January 1, 2010, and operative for taxable years beginning on or after that date.
