AB 1178 as amended May 27, 2010, would have created a teacher credit and would have included in a water's-edge taxpayer's return income derived from or attributable to a tax haven.

The June 16, 2010, amendments removed the teacher credit and tax haven provisions and added provisions relating to Property Tax Law, therefore, this bill no longer impacts the department's programs and operations or state tax revenue.
