This bill would require a state agency to accept a registered warrant for payment of any state obligation.

COMMENTS:

The August 10, 2010, amendments made a minor change to remove provisions from the bill that would allow types of indebtedness, other than registered warrants, to be used as forms of payment for obligations to state agencies.

These amendments would not impact the department’s programs, operations, or state income tax revenue. The analysis of the bill as amended August 31, 2009, still applies.
