This bill would make changes to the Penal Code relating to criminal procedure.
The May 12, 2010, amendments removed language that would have provided disaster loss treatment for losses sustained as a result of the October and November, 2008, Los Angeles County and the October, 2008, Ventura County wildfire and added language that would amend the Penal Code.
As a result of the amendments, this bill no longer impacts the department’s programs and operations or state income tax revenue. The department’s analysis of the bill as introduced March 25, 2009, no longer applies.
