SUMMARY

This bill would remove the repeal date for the California Sexual Violence Victim Services Fund and would make changes to the Penal Code related to treatment of sex offenders.

COMMENTS:

The July 15, 2010, amendments would remove the repeal date of the California Sexual Violence Victim Services Fund in the Revenue and Taxation Code. The amendments would also make changes to the Penal Code related to the treatment of sex offenders.

This bill would not impact the department’s programs, operations, or state income tax revenue because the amendments do not require a voluntary fund designation to be placed on the personal income tax return.

According to the author’s office, the purpose of this amendment is to retain the fund, within the Treasury department, and its allocation provisions.
