**COMMENTS:**

This bill would exempt employees of the Franchise Tax Board and the State Board of Equalization from furloughs, unless specifically authorized by the Legislature.

The May 28, 2010, amendments removed the employees of the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation and the Employment Development Department from the furlough exemption that would be provided under this bill. These amendments do not impact the department’s programs or operations. The prior analysis of the bill as introduced February 17, 2010, still applies.
