SUMMARY

This bill would prohibit the Director of General Services bundling contracts.

COMMENTS:

The August 2, 2010, amendments would restrict the prohibition of bundling contracts to the Director of General Services and would remove the prohibition of counting subcontracting dollars toward small business or disabled veterans' business enterprises goals.

As a result of the amendments, this bill no longer impacts the department's programs and operations or state income tax revenue. The department's analysis of the bill as amended June 14, 2010, no longer applies.
