**SUBJECT:** Personal Information/Social Security Numbers/State Agencies Shall Not Present To County Recorder Documents Containing More Than Last 4 Digits Of A Social Security Number

**COMMENTS:**

This bill would require that any document created on or after January 1, 2010, containing more than four digits of a social security number (SSN) is not entitled to be recorded when presented to a county recorder’s office.

The August 17, 2009, amendments made changes to the county recorder’s due diligence requirement to truncate SSNs on recorded documents, which do not impact the department programs, operations, costs, or state income tax revenues. The remainder of the department’s analysis of the bill as amended March 31, 2009, still applies.
