SUBJECT: State Agencies Provide Statement Of Earnings And Deductions To Employees Electronically

Senate Bill 37 (Strickland), as enacted on October 11, 2009, made the following changes to laws impacting the Franchise Tax Board:

Section 19849.7 of the Government Code is amended.

This act requires electronic distribution of wage and earning statements for state employees who receive direct deposit of wages unless a paper statement was specifically requested by the employee.

This act is effective on January 1, 2010, and operative as of that date. The provisions of this act are contingent upon the funding and implementation of the Controller's "21st Century Project" and is conditioned on that project enabling the Controller to provide the wage and salary statement electronically.

This act will not require any reports by the department to the Legislature.
