SUBJECT: Personal Information/Social Security Numbers/County Recorder Reject Any Documents That Contain More Than Last 4 Digits of Social Security Number

Senate Bill 40 (Correa), as enacted on October 11, 2009, made the following changes to laws impacting the Franchise Tax Board:

Section 1798.89 of the Civil Code is repealed and added.

This act provides that any document created on or after January 1, 2010, containing more than four digits of a social security number is not entitled to be recorded when presented to a county recorder's office.

This act is effective on January 1, 2010, and specifically operative for documents created on or after that date.

This act will not require any reports by the department to the Legislature.
