**SUBJECT:** State Agencies Submit Required Reports As Printed Copies To Legislative Counsel And Secretary Of Senate, As Electronic Copies To Chief Clerk Of Assembly, And Electronic Copies of Summaries Of Required Reports To Members Of Legislature

**Assembly Bill 1585 (Committee on Accountability & Administrative Review), as enacted on February 26, 2010, made the following changes to laws impacting the Franchise Tax Board:**

Section 9795 of the Government Code is amended.

This provision revised the distribution method of legislatively mandated reports by requiring all state and local agencies, including the Franchise Tax Board, to provide a printed copy of any required report to both the Legislative Counsel and the Secretary of the Senate, and an electronic copy of any required report to the Chief Clerk of the Assembly. In addition, this provision requires all state agencies to submit an electronic copy of the summary of any required report to each member of the houses of the Legislature, as appropriate.

This act is effective on February 26, 2010, and operative as of that date.

This act will not require any new reports by the department to the Legislature.
