SUBJECT: Business Expense Deduction/Prohibit Deduction For Discriminatory Clubs Technical Amendment

SUMMARY

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to a provision of the Revenue and Taxation Code pertaining to the Corporation Tax Law that prohibits deductions for a club that restricts membership or the use of its services or facilities on the basis of ancestry or other characteristics.

ANALYSIS

It appears that this is a spot bill. As a spot bill, this bill would not impact the department's programs and operations or the state's income tax revenue.
