SUBJECT: Victim-Witness Assistance Fund

SUMMARY

This bill would allow taxpayers to make voluntary contributions to the Victim-Witness Assistance Fund (Fund) on their state personal income tax returns.

ANALYSIS

The April 12, 2011, amendments added a coauthor, would require the Franchise Tax Board to notify the Controller of the amount of contributions designated for the Fund, and would require the Controller to transfer the designated funds from the Personal Income Tax Fund to the Fund. The amendments would also make other technical, nonsubstantive changes.

The department’s analysis of the bill as introduced February 17, 2011, still applies.
