**SUBJECT:** Peace Officers/City Of Los Angeles

No analysis required - Not within our scope of responsibility.

**SUMMARY**

This bill would modify the Penal Code’s definition of persons that are peace officers whose authority may extend to any place in the state.

**ANALYSIS**

The August 20, 2012, amendments would have defined eligibility requirements and priority of grants for Cal Grants awarded from the Higher Education investment Tax Credit Program Special Fund. The Franchise Tax Board would have been required to send a letter, as specified, to the Student Aid Commission in order for the bill to become operative.

The August 23, 2012, amendments removed all of the bill’s provisions regarding Cal Grants and replaced it with provisions that would modify the definition of peace officers under the Penal Code. As a result of the August 23, 2012, amendments, this bill no longer impacts the department’s programs and operations or state income tax revenue.
