SUBJECT: School Supplies For Homeless Children Fund

SUMMARY

This bill would allow a taxpayer to make a voluntary contribution to the School Supplies for Homeless Children Fund on the state personal income tax return.

ANALYSIS

Minor/Technical Amendment

The April 18, 2012, amendments resolved the department’s implementation considerations as provided in the analysis of the bill as introduced on February 24, 2012, by designating a state agency to administer the funds. The amendments also add a provision specifying that voluntary contributions made to the School Supplies for Homeless Children Fund can be taken as an itemized deduction on the state personal income tax return for the year in which the voluntary contribution was made.

These amendments do not impact the department’s programs and operations or state income tax revenue. The department’s analysis of the bill as introduced February 24, 2012, still applies.
