**SUBJECT:** California Public Employees' Retirement System - Retirees Who Have Not Reinstated May Not Perform Services For State Until Separated From Service For At Least 180 Days

**SUMMARY**

This bill would, among other provisions that would not impact the Franchise Tax Board (FTB), prohibit any retired member of the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CALPERS) that has not reinstated to active service after retirement from performing services for any employer whose employees are covered by CALPERS until separated from service for at least 180 days.

**ANALYSIS**

The August 15, 2011, amendments made technical changes and added provisions to the bill relating to collectively bargained agreements with employees of the California State University. These amendments would not impact the FTB. The department's analysis of this bill as amended March 3, 2011, still applies.
