SUMMARY

This bill would allow a taxpayer to make a voluntary contribution to the Habitat for Humanity Fund on the state personal income tax return.

ANALYSIS

Minor/Technical Amendment

The August 14, 2014, amendments added language that would provide reimbursement to the Department of Housing and Community Development for their costs associated with administering the Habitat for Humanity Fund. These amendments do not impact the department's programs, operations, or state income tax revenue.

The department's analysis of the bill as amended June 4, 2014, still applies.
