SUBJECT: Department of Justice Gun Buyback Program

No analysis required - Not within our scope of responsibility.

SUMMARY

This bill would, under the Penal Code, establish a Gun Buyback Program in the Department of Justice, which would consist of local buyback programs administered by police or sheriff departments.

ANALYSIS

The January 6, 2014, amendments removed the income tax provisions that would have created a tax credit for a gun or assault weapon that was either surrendered or sold to local law enforcement in a gun buyback program and added the provisions discussed above. As a result of the amendments, this bill no longer impacts the department's programs and operations or state income tax revenue.
