SUBJECT: California Sexual Violence Victim Services Fund

SUMMARY

Under the Revenue and Taxation Code, this bill would reestablish the California Sexual Violence Victim Services Fund (Victim Services Fund) voluntary contribution and allow taxpayers to make contributions on their state personal income tax returns.

ANALYSIS

Minor/Technical Amendment

The January 17, 2014, amendments added language that would trigger the addition of the Victim Services Fund to the personal income tax return when space becomes available, and would modify the administration and use of contributions made to this fund.

These amendments do not impact the department’s programs and operations or state income tax revenue. The department’s analysis of the bill as amended January 6, 2014, still applies.
