## SUMMARY

Under the Revenue and Taxation Code, this bill would reestablish the California Sexual Violence Victim Services Fund (Victim Services Fund) voluntary contribution and allow taxpayers to make contributions on their state personal income tax returns.

## ANALYSIS

### Minor/Technical Amendment

The July 2, 2014, amendments added a co-author and modified provisions that detail the responsibilities of the Office of Emergency Services with regard to a grant program for rape crisis centers in California. These amendments do not impact the department’s programs, operations, or state income tax revenue.

The department’s analysis of the bill as amended January 6, 2014, still applies.
