SUBJECT: FTB Collect Restitution Orders Referred by Counties/Prohibit Referrals if County Board of Supervisors Designated County Agency to Collect

SUMMARY

This bill would limit the ability of the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation or a county from referring specified debts to the Franchise Tax Board (FTB) for collection.

This bill also would make changes to provisions of the Penal Code that are not administered by the department and are not discussed in this analysis.

ANALYSIS

The August 1, 2016, amendments made a number of technical changes that do not impact the FTB. Except for the "Implementation Considerations" section, which was resolved by the June 27, 2016, amendments, the department's analysis of the bill as introduced February 16, 2016, and amended April 6, 2016, still applies.
