**SUBJECT:** Court Ordered Debt/Juvenile Court Collection Referrals

## SUMMARY

This bill would modify provisions of the Government, Penal, and Welfare and Institutions Codes relating to minors.

## ANALYSIS

The April 6, 2016, amendments removed an amendment to the Revenue and Taxation Code that would have removed the authority to refer debts under Section 903.1 of the Welfare and Institution Code to the Franchise Tax Board for collection. Therefore this bill no longer impacts the Franchise Tax Board.
