Steps to a State Job

Step 1: Search

Visit **calcareers.ca.gov** to find open positions. We need new employees in all career fields.

The "Get a State Job" section allows you to browse available jobs by career field. You can search using keywords, job titles, or state departments. Use the advanced search to filter by location, work schedule, and salary. Once you find the job you want, read the job bulletin to see the qualifications needed. It also explains the job, lists the salary range, and gives you an overview of the assessment process.

Step 2: Assessment

Assessments and exams evaluate your education, experience, abilities, and knowledge.

If you're interested and qualified, you can start an assessment or schedule to take an exam. Once you pass, you are eligible to apply for jobs!

Step 3: Application

Fill out the standard state application template in your CalCareer Account. You can create up to ten application templates and tailor each one to a different job category. Use one application template to apply for multiple vacancies in the same job category. If needed, resumes and writing samples can be uploaded as attachments.
