

Administrative Dissolution Programs Strategic Goal #1

Taxpayer Centric Service:

Enhance our services to help taxpayers fulfill their tax obligations



Administrative Dissolution Programs – Nonprofits Lifecycle of Compliant Nonprofits

Creation

- Register with Secretary of State (SOS)
- Apply for Exemption with Franchise Tax Board (FTB)
- Register with Attorney General (AG)

Compliance

-Regularly file with SOS, FTB, AG

Dissolution

- -Approval from Nonprofit's Board and AG
- -File to Dissolve with SOS

Administrative Dissolution Programs – Nonprofits Non-Compliant Nonprofits

Non-Compliance Leads to:

- -Suspension
- Loss of tax exempt status
- -Taxes assessed as general corporation

Path to Resolution:

- –File corporation tax returns
- –Pay back taxes
- -Dissolve

Administrative Dissolution Programs – Nonprofits Non-Compliant Nonprofits

Magnitude of the Problem

-140K Suspended Nonprofits

Resolution

- -Collaborated with AG, SOS and taxpayer community
- -Legislation passed January 1, 2016

Administrative Dissolution Programs – Nonprofits

Implementation of New Program

- Collaboration Partnership: FTB, SOS, AG
- Three New Paths for Nonprofits to Dissolve
 - Short Form Dissolution Created in Error
 - Voluntary Dissolution Taxpayer Initiated
 - –Administrative Dissolution FTB Initiated
- Community Education and Outreach

Administrative Dissolution Programs – Nonprofits Success Metrics

- Short Form
 - -2,500 successfully dissolved by SOS
- Voluntary Dissolution to Date
 - -Over 1,700 requests received 90% approved
 - -Almost 900 successfully dissolved
- Administrative Dissolution to Date
 - -Over 64,000 Dissolved
 - –160 Getting Back into Compliance

Administrative Dissolution Programs – Corps & LLCs Background

- December 2015 Taxpayers' Bill of Rights Hearing
- Collaborative Efforts: FTB, SOS and Go-Biz
- Legislative Proposal drafted in 2017
- Assembly Bill 2503 (September 2018)

Administrative Dissolution Programs – Corps & LLCs Implementation of New Program

- Two New Paths for Administrative Dissolution
 - Voluntary Dissolution Taxpayer Initiated
 - Administrative Dissolution FTB Initiated

Administrative Dissolution Programs – Corps & LLCs Implementation of New Program

- Voluntary Dissolution
 - -Partnership with SOS
 - -Outreach efforts
 - -Successfully implemented on time, January 1, 2019
 - -Statistics to date
- Administrative Dissolution Coming January 2020
