



You may qualify for ReadyReturn if you filed a California resident return last year with

- Single filing status
- No dependents
- No special credits
- Standard deduction
- Only one employer

If you checked each box, you may be eligible for ReadyReturn.

Now even more people qualify!



ReadyReturn is available to taxpayers who:

- Use the head of household filing status.
- Received the renter's credit last year.
- Can be claimed as a dependent on another taxpayer's return.
- Have up to five dependents.

Taxpayers can also sign up for an email notification when their ReadyReturn is available.

Get it online or call us and we'll mail it to you.

- > Go to ftb.ca.gov and enter **ReadyReturn** in the search box.
- > Follow the online instructions. Requires your Social Security Number and Customer Service Number.*
** Your Customer Service Number is a four-digit number we assign you each year. Get it online using information from your 2006 California tax return.*
- > Call **800.338.0505** and request that your ReadyReturn be mailed to you. Requires your Social Security Number, street address, and ZIP code.
- > If you e-file you can get your refund in less than one week using direct deposit or if you owe, schedule an online payment.
- > If you're not eligible for ReadyReturn, you can try CalFile. Go to ftb.ca.gov and search for **CalFile**. Then follow the online instructions. *CalFile esta disponible en español.*
- > Federal Earned Income Tax Credit is for low-income working people. Find out if you qualify for this refundable credit. Visit irs.gov and search for **EITC**.


