SUBJECT: FTB Include Voter Registration Information In PIT Return Pamphlet Of Instructions

COMMENTS:

This bill would require the Franchise Tax Board (FTB) to provide voter registration information provided by the Secretary of State (SOS) to taxpayers by either:

- including an insert prepared by the Secretary of State containing voter registration information in the pamphlet of instructions that accompanies personal income tax returns; or
- providing space for the voter registration information in the pamphlet of instructions that accompanies personal income tax returns.

This bill also would require every state agency to continually make available voter registration cards in a conspicuous location in any office or offices where the public regularly conducts business with the agency.

This bill also would make changes to various code sections not administered by the FTB.

The January 21, 1999, amendments inserted a provision in the Education Code that declares it is the intent of the Legislature to include voter registration information forms in the enrollment materials provided to University of California students each year. This amendment also deleted the property tax provisions requiring county tax collectors to include voter registration information with every property tax bill and made changes to the date by which some agencies must take action.

These changes do not affect the department and the analysis of the original bill as introduced December 7, 1998, still applies.
