SUMMARY OF BILL

This bill would create the Grant Information Act of 1999 and require all state agencies to include a listing of all grants and applicable forms administered by that state agency on the Internet.

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT

The June 17, 1999, amendment added language that would require a state agency to include with the listing of grants administered by that state agency an executive summary of each grant that would include specific information regarding the grant.

As a result of the amendment and further interpretation of the bill, the department concluded that its information sharing agreements would not fall within the scope of this bill and would not require the department to include on its website any confidential information. Therefore, the department's implementation consideration identified in the department's analysis of AB 187 as amended March 25, 1999, no longer applies.

Except for these changes, the department's analyses of AB 187 as amended March 25, 1999, and April 15, 1999, still apply.
