COMMENTS:

Under the Welfare and Institutions Code, **this bill** would appropriate \$500,000 to increase Medi-Cal reimbursement to critical access hospitals. Critical access hospitals are small hospitals located in geographically isolated areas.

The August 7, 2000, amendment deleted the previous provisions that would have established the Animal Population Control Fund as a voluntary contribution on the income tax return and added the language discussed above. This bill no longer impacts the department or state income tax revenue.
